

Sheer, Draped Ceiling Treatment with AriA™ Metal Hardware

A ceiling treatment can create visual drama, soften a space and absorb sound for more private conversations. In our Quaint Café, we created a swag treatment and installed it to the ceiling with decorative AriA[™] Metal Hardware.

Sheer, Draped Ceiling Treatment with AriA[™] Metal Hardware: Step-By-Step Instructions

This how-to guide covers the steps to fabricate a swag ceiling treatment as well as installation steps. Our ceiling treatment finished at 54" wide, had 5 swoops and used 96" of fabric in each swoop. Each swoop covered 78" of the ceiling.



Cutting and Prepping the Face Fabric:



Make a plan for number of swoops, length and width of each swoop and the size rod pocket needed for the hardware you want to use.



Figure cuts and seams as needed.




Join pieces as needed.

If using a sheer, plan to do French seams to hide any raw edges.





- Turn under and finish a double $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " side hem on both long sides.
- On both ends, turn under and close a rod pocket large enough for your hardware.
 - We used a 5" rod pocket.



- Measure down fabric length to next rod pocket.
- Fold in rod pocket and stitch across to close.





Complete until all rod pockets are completed.

Installing the Treatment:




Measure and mark for bracket placement.




Take brackets apart.


















Do for all rod pockets.
