

## **Instructions For Installing Zipper Slides On Closed Zippers** (For open zippers please see the reverse side.)

Before cutting a zipper from the roll, make sure you add an extra 4 inches to the overall length.

Warning: We strongly advise against using your best fabric scissors to cut zippers.


Please use a scissor made for general rough cutting such as our 8 inch Utility Shears (Stk# CU8/U).


### Use the following 3 steps to install any zipper slide on the correct zipper as shown below.


1. Start with a clean, even cut, non-frayed zipper end. Trim with scissors if necessary.


2. Feed the narrow end of the zipper slide onto the zipper end and press down. For zipper direction and zipper slide/pull positions see below.

3. Grasp each side of the zipper at the very top and pull away from the center. The slide will feed itself on to the zipper.











### **Nylon Zippers and Zipper Slides (All Colors)**

Nylon Zippers have no direction but they have a front and back side. Each Nylon Zipper Slide must be installed as shown below. Nylon Zipper Slides do not lock and can be installed on either end of the Nylon Zipper.

### Aluminum/Brass Zippers (All Colors) and Aluminum/Brass Zipper Slides

Aluminum/Brass Zippers have direction but do not have a front or back side. Slides can be installed on either side of the zipper. Aluminum/Brass Zipper Slides have locking positions and must be installed in the positions shown below.

**Brass Teeth Pointing Up Indicates Correct Direction Brass Zipper Slide Positions** (Stk# EBP2)







### Molded Tooth Zippers and Zipper Slides (All Colors)


Molded Tooth Zippers do not have direction or a front side and back side.

Molded Tooth Zipper Slides do not lock and can be installed on either side or either end of the zipper.

# Instructions For Installing Zipper Slides On Open Zippers (For closed zippers please see the reverse side.)


Before cutting a zipper from the roll, make sure you add an extra 4 inches to the overall length.


Please use a scissor made for general rough cutting such as our 8 inch Utility Shears (Stk# CU8/U).

### Use the following 3 steps to install any zipper slide on the correct zipper as shown below.


 Start with two clean, even cut, non-frayed open zipper ends.
Trim with scissors if necessary.



2. Hold the zipper slide head between your thumb and forefinger. Feed each zipper end into the wide end of the zipper slide head slightly offset. For zipper direction and zipper slide head/pull positions see below.



3. Grasp the edge of the longer zipper end with the other hand. Pull the zipper through the slide



Grasp the longer zipper end and pull through the slide.

Hold the zipper slide head between your thumb and forefinger.

### **Nylon Zippers and Zipper Slides (All Colors)**

Nylon Zippers have no direction but they have a front and back side. Each Nylon Zipper Slide must be installed as shown below. Nylon Zipper Slides do not lock and can be installed on either end of the Nylon Zipper.



### Aluminum/Brass Zippers (All Colors) and Aluminum/Brass Zipper Slides

Aluminum/Brass Zippers have direction but do not have a front or back side. Slides can be installed on either side of the zipper. Aluminum/Brass Zipper Slides have locking positions and must be installed in the positions shown below.
