
Suggested uses for Iron-On Bonding Tape


(Can be used when covering most welt cords)

With fabric tab for use when making pillows, top treatments, bedspreads, etc.

- Cut fabric on the bias.
- Lay the welt cording in the center of fabric.
- Peel release paper off (FT37) iron-on bonding tape.
 Place iron-on bonding tape beside welt cord.
- Fold fabric over and iron, with heat and steam setting.



For small diameter welt cord use narrow width iron-on bonding tape. For large diameter welt cord use wider width iron-on bonding tape.



- 5. Some fabrics may require iron-on bonding tape on both sides, while others will only need it on one side.

 When shirring fabric on the welt cord be sure to allow
